While our work is not limited to quantitative data, this particular role, which draws upon fields such as opinion polling, data science and customer satisfaction research, has a strong quantitative focus.

The job

Responsibilities

- Works in team and independently on day-to-day data analysis of quantitative perception surveys, independently conducting analysis of standardised survey data
- Continually improves our analysis tools
- Collaborates closely with other analysts in team and provides advice on how best report findings of quantitative data collections

- Processes internal and external data requests
- Supports on sampling and research design of surveys
- Data quality control and data cleaning
- Updating our database of humanitarian feedback data

Core requirements

- Experienced in quantitative data analysis using R
- Sound knowledge of statistics (we frequently use: non-parametric statistics, significance testing, logistic regression) and expect candidates to be comfortable using these and similar methods and ability to explain concepts to non-technical colleagues
- Strong analytical skills with attention to detail and accuracy
- Pragmatism needed to work in humanitarian contexts
- Degree: flexible, social or natural science, engineering, If natural science/engineering degree ideally with additional skills in experience in social science desirable. If social science degree: strong quantitative focus

Desirable

- Expertise in survey design and sampling
- Coding skills in Python and SQL
- Skills in data visualisation and communication
- Experience in customer satisfaction research, political polling or in the development and humanitarian sector

What we offer

The position will ideally be based in Vienna, where we can offer a contract (full time) with a competitive package under Austrian law with the possibility of extension. We have a flexible working culture, however, and if the location is prohibitive for you but you tick all the other boxes, please apply anyway, and explain this in your application.
